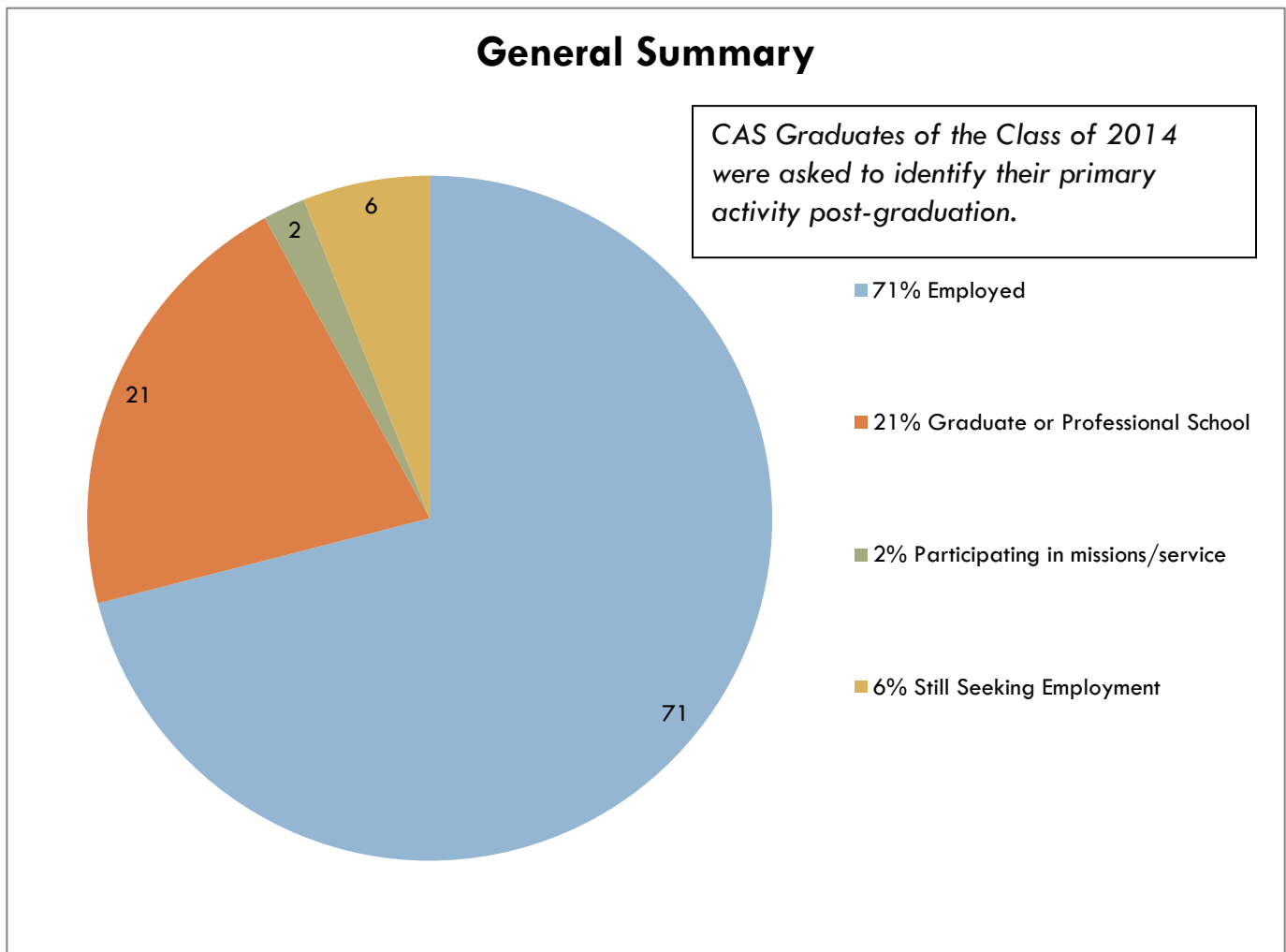

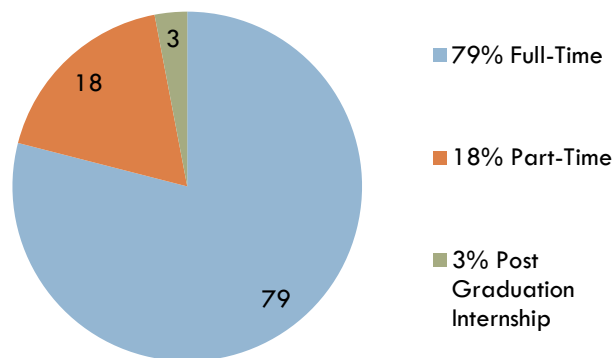
***56% of the Class of 2014 participated in this survey (179 of 320 graduates).**

EMPLOYMENT

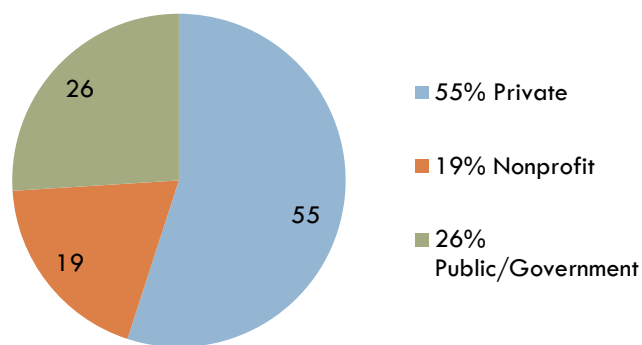
71% of the CAS Class of 2014 survey respondents reported employment as their primary activity following graduation. 79% of those employed are working in full-time positions.

80% of employed graduates indicate their current job is related or somewhat related to their major. 88% of employed graduates are very satisfied or satisfied with their current employment.

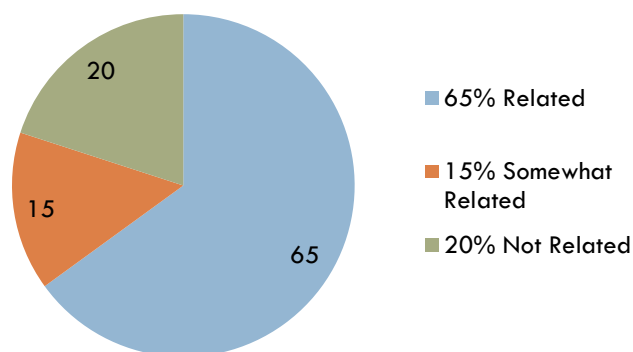
Type of Employment



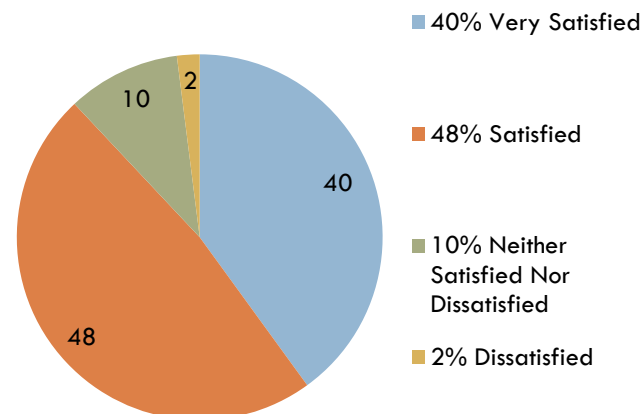
Area of Employment

Satisfaction with Current Employment

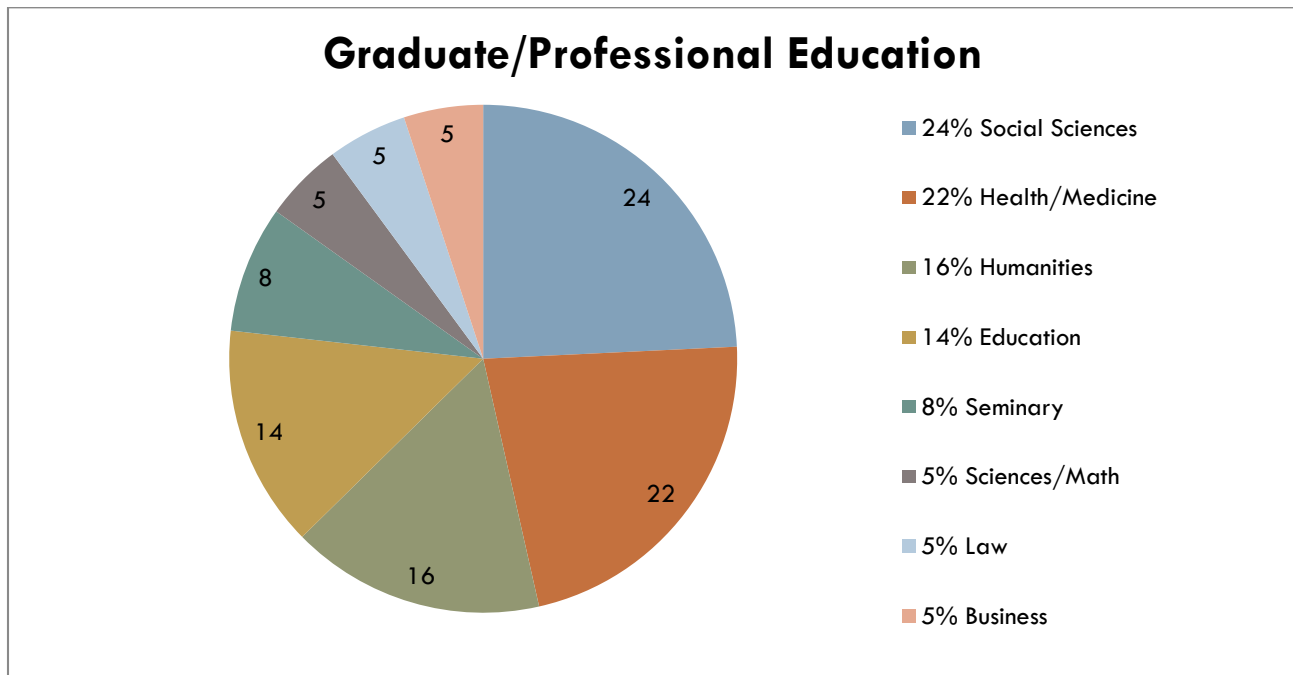

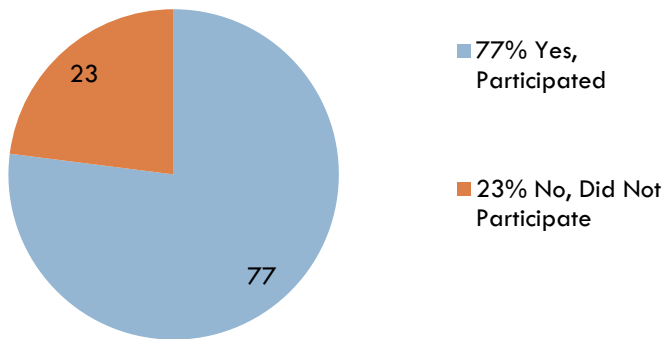

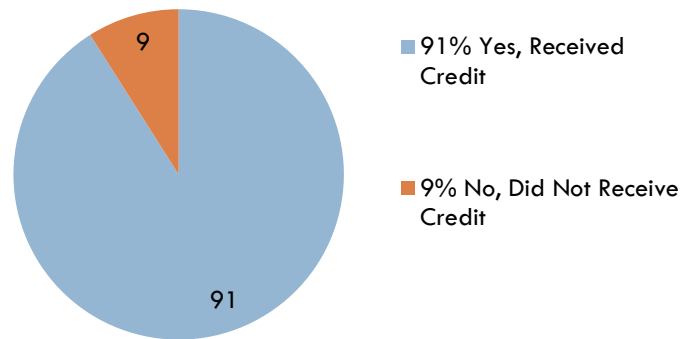
INTERNSHIPS & PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE

77% of the CAS Class of 2014 survey respondents reported participating in an internship/student teaching/practical experience while enrolled at Eastern. 91% of those received academic credit for those experiences. The majority of respondents completed internships during senior year (71%).

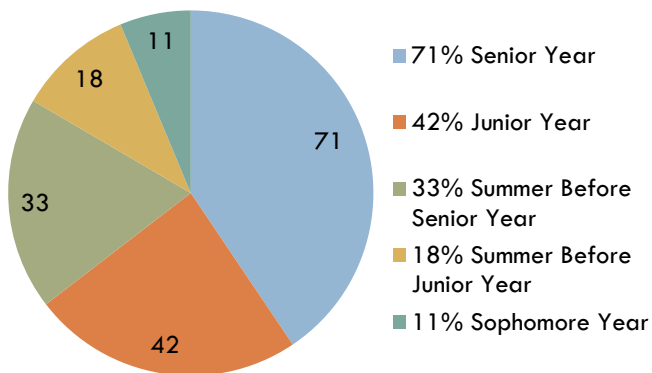
Students Who Participated In Internships/Practical Experience Prior to Graduation



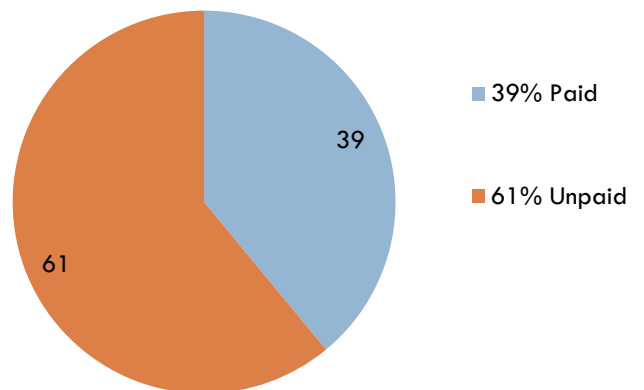
Students Who Received Academic Credit at EU for their Internships/ Practical Experiences

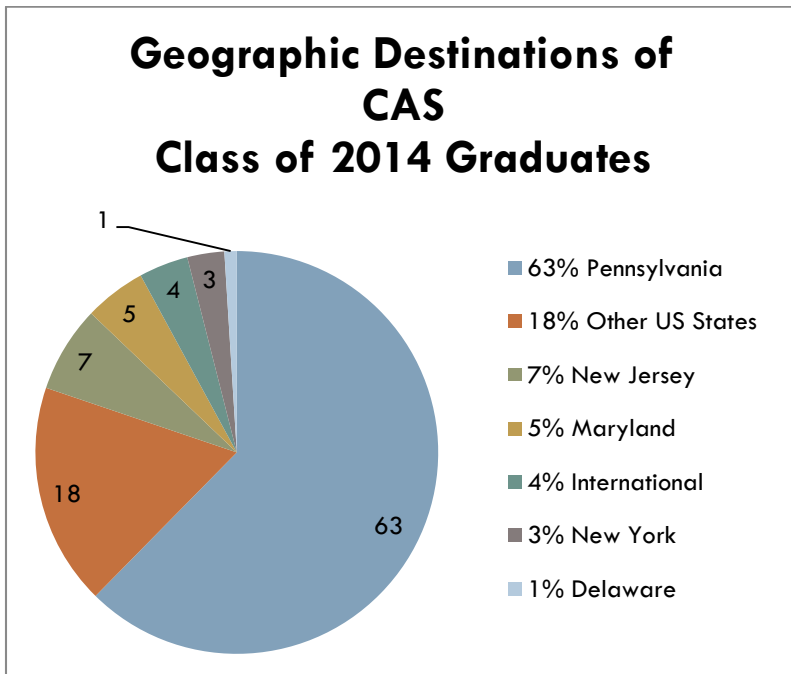

63% of CAS Class of 2014 survey respondents reside in Pennsylvania, but our graduates can be found all over the United States and beyond. Some members of the Class of 2014 live overseas in Guatemala, Albania, Spain, Nicaragua, Hungary, Ghana, and Bolivia.



55% of CAS 2014 graduates sought individual career counseling from Eastern University Talent and Career Development during their senior year at Eastern.
